Upon consideration of the Defendants' joint motion to extend time to respond to the United States discovery requests and for good cause appearing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** the motion is **GRANTED**. The Defendants' Motions to Quash<sup>1</sup> are hereby granted and pending the entry of a protective order by Court in this case and the United States Motions to Compel<sup>2</sup> are hereby denied. Both the parties motions to quash and the motions to compel shall be resolved by the entry of a protective order in this case and shall be considered moot at that time. Further, the deadline for the Defendants to respond to outstanding discovery requests from the United States shall be sixty (60) days after the entry of a protective order in this case which shall resolve the outstanding protective order issues pending before this Court.
