
R. Wayne Klein, the court-appointed receiver, filed a Fifteenth Fee Application for Services Rendered from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 ("Fifteenth Fee Application," Doc. No. 1223). No opposition was filed. For good cause shown, the court ORDERS:

1. The Fifteenth Fee Application is APPROVED.
2. The fees and expenses incurred by the receiver and his professionals, as set forth in the Fifteenth Fee Application, are reasonable and necessary, and may be paid as an expense of administering the receivership estate.
3. The receiver is authorized to pay the receiver, Klein & Associates, PLLC, Parr Brown Gee & Loveless, P.C., Manning Curtis Bradshaw & Bednar, PLLC, and Lone Peak Valuation Group \$86,521.50 in fees for services rendered for the benefit of the receivership

estate from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022, and \$1,833.84 as reimbursement of expenses paid on behalf of the receivership estate.
