ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION TO ASSIGN ADDITIONAL JUDGMENT TO PLAINTIFF, UNITED STATES

R. Wayne Klein, the court-appointed receiver, filed a Motion to Assign Additional Judgment to Plaintiff, United States.¹ The receiver seeks to assign an additional judgment he has obtained to the United States for collection.² (*Id.* at 2.) No oppositions to the motion were filed and the United States supports the motion. For the reasons described in this court's order granting a prior motion to assign judgments,³ the assignment is in the best interest of the receivership estate and the motion is GRANTED.

The court orders as follows:

- 1. The judgment in *Klein v. Shepard*, 2:19-cv-00533 shall be assigned to the United States.
- 2. The Receiver is directed to file a notice of assignment in the case from which the assigned judgment originated.

- 3. The United States shall send a status report to the receiver updating him on the amount collected from the assigned judgment at least every six months.
- 4. The receiver shall file a status report with the court informing the court as to the amount the United States has collected on the assigned judgment. The status report shall be filed annually and at such time as the United States has recovered \$14.2 million per the Corrected Receivership Order's second distribution priority (Doc. No. 491).
