For good cause shown, the Court ORDERS:

1. The Nineteenth Fee Application is APPROVED.
2. The fees and expenses incurred by the receiver and his professionals, as set forth in the Nineteenth Fee Application, are reasonable and necessary, and may be paid as an expense of administering the receivership estate.
3. The receiver is authorized to pay \$19,000.00 to the Receiver and Klein & Associates, PLLC, \$10,622.50 to Parr Brown Gee & Loveless, P.C., and \$2,894.25 to Lone Peak
