

1. The Twentieth Fee Application is APPROVED.
2. The fees and expenses incurred by the receiver and his professionals, as set forth in the Twentieth Fee Application, are reasonable and necessary, and may be paid as an expense of administering the receivership estate.

3. The receiver is authorized to pay the receiver and Parr Brown Gee & Loveless, P.C., \$68,086.00 in fees and expenses for services rendered for the benefit of the receivership estate from July 1, 2023 through September 30, 2023.
