>> To All:  
>> The IRS still believes that we are a sham, but still no  
>> date on their expert witness. The IRS has a new tactic:  
>> that you are involved in a hobby and not a business. The  
>> logic being that your lenses have produced no income.  
>> Update: The progress we are making is really exciting.  
>> The last little hurdles have been overcome by successfully

>> the number of frames that can be produced. We now have  
>> those answers. Two employees per station with a very low  
>> cost-better than expected - while being able to produce  
>> 120 completed solar frames per hour using all four  
>> auto-weld stations.  
>> It is now estimated that we can put up all of the lenses  
>> purchased by RaPower3 Team Members on working towers in  
>> less than a month. This includes all solar lenses purchased  
>> since the very beginning until now. The two photos show  
>> the auto-weld framing station and the inventory of  
>> completed frames that is growing every day.  
>> Bonuses: When a thousand working towers are erected, then  
>> significant money can be earned by International Automated  
>> Systems. This would mean that bonus monies can be paid.  
>> The game plan is to have these all up this year.  
>> IRS Implications: When the towers start going up and  
>> producing, then the IRS position against us will be  
>> severely weakened. When the bonuses start being paid, it  
>> shoots down the IRS theory that you became involved only  
>> for the tax benefits. Same with the rental fees.  
>> Court News: There is a test case in the works with one  
>> RaPower3 Team Member. When that actually materializes,  
>> the outcome of that test case would, of course, be  
>> relevant to all the others. I still don't know about  
>> their expert witness. There is no firm date. So, until  
>> they get their expert witness down to Delta, we cannot  
>> move forward on the test case. I am quite sure there will  
>> be no test case this month. But that's OK. We keep  
>> moving forward every day and that means the IRS case  
>> against us becomes weaker every day.

>> In conclusion, we have new strategies being looked at by  
>> our team of attorneys that appear to make our case even  
>> stronger. More on that later.

>> I want you to stay positive. We have a lot of exciting  
>> things happening. The future looks bright. Everything  
>> will turn out well.
