This matter came before the court on Defendant Neldon P. Johnson’s motion for limited relief from the asset freeze order (ECF Doc. 444) to lift the order as relates to his personal account at Bank of American Fork into which is deposited his federal social security income (“SSI”). The Receiver, Wayne Klein, does not oppose the motion to the limited extent of allowing the deposit of Mr. Johnson’s SSI only and allowing Mr. Johnson to receive and use future SSI payments.

THEREFORE, for good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The account at Bank of American Fork in the name of Neldon P. Johnson (Account No. ****233) is hereby released from the asset freeze order (ECF Doc. 444).
2. Mr. Johnson may receive and use the SSI funds.

3. Mr. Johnson will provide monthly bank statements for the referenced account at Bank of American Fork each month within the first week of the month to verify the only funds deposited into the account are the SSI funds.
