Before the Court is the United States' motion for entry of an order that R. Gregory Shepard pay a sum certain for its attorney's fees and costs related to bringing its Motion for Order to Show Cause Why R. Gregory Shepard Should Not Be Held in Civil Contempt of Court¹ and enforcing the Court's Order In re: Civil Contempt of R. Gregory Shepard (the "Order")². The motion is GRANTED. Pursuant to the Order, Defendant R. Gregory Shepard shall pay the United States' attorney's fees and costs totaling \$3,273.79 in funds separate from property belonging to the Receiver or the receivership estate.³ No later than thirty (30) days from the date of this order, R. Gregory Shepard shall deliver to counsel for the United States a certified check made payable to "U.S. Department of Justice" in the amount of \$3,273.79.
