Purchasing through www.rapower3.com gives the purchaser free lifetime membership to RaPower3 and makes them an independent contractor to the company - this is important because this status will give the owner the ability to claim depreciation on the lenses as well, which is a huge deal and will entitle you to commissions should you choose to invite others to participate.
