PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Creditor the United States Department of Justice, Tax Division, has filed papers with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, Motion to Dismiss Bankruptcy Petition, or in the Alternative, Convert to Chapter 7, or Appoint Chapter 11 Trustee. This motion asks that the Court dismiss RaPower-3, LLC's bankruptcy petition, or in the alternative, to convert it to a Chapter 7, or appoint a Chapter 11 trustee.

YOUR RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.

If you do not want the Court to dismiss RaPower-3's bankruptcy petition, convert the petition to Chapter 7, or appoint a Chapter 11 trustee, then you or your attorney must take the following step:

On or before August 10, 2018 (if you were served via CM/ECF) or August 17, 2018 (if you were served by mail) file with the Bankruptcy Court a written Objection explaining your position. Your written objection must be filed electronically, by mail, or by hand-delivery at:

If you mail your objection to the Bankruptcy Court for filing, it must be deposited in the U.S. Mail in sufficient time for it to be received by the Court on or before August 10, 2018 (if you were served via CM/ECF) or August 17, 2018 (if you were served by mail). If you or your attorney do not take this step, the Bankruptcy Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought in the motion to dismiss RaPower-3's bankruptcy petition, convert the petition to Chapter 7, or appoint a Chapter 11 trustee and may enter an order granting that relief.
