Poulsen, PC in this case, the Receiver need not personally serve nor mail the OSC Motion and

the Report and Recommendation to Glenda Johnson.

4. Any response to the OSC Motion and Report and Recommendation must be filed

no later than Friday, January 29, 2021.

5. The Receiver may file a reply in support of the OSC Motion and Report and

Recommendation no later than Friday, February 5, 2021.

6. At its discretion, the Court may hold a hearing or, pursuant to DUCivR 7-1(f), the

Court may consider the OSC Motion and Report and Recommendation on the written

memoranda of the parties.
