In accordance with the Civil Contempt Order re: Glenda Johnson, Roger Hamblin, and Preston Olsen ("Contempt Order"),<sup>1</sup> court-appointed receiver R. Wayne Klein (the "Receiver") filed a motion (the "Motion")<sup>2</sup> seeking an award of attorneys' fees and costs in the total amount of \$69,518.54.<sup>3</sup> No response to the Motion has been filed, and the time to file a response has now expired.<sup>4</sup> Therefore, for the reasons stated in the Contempt Order and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED.
- 2. In accordance with the Contempt Order, Glenda Johnson, Roger Hamblin, and

Preston Olsen are jointly and severally liable to the Receiver for the total amount of \$69,518.54, minus the \$16,000.00 that has already been paid to the Receiver by Roger Hamblin and Preston

Olsen.<sup>5</sup> The remaining amount of \$53,518.54 must be paid in funds separate from property belonging to the Receiver or receivership estate.

3. The amounts due to the Receiver set forth in paragraph 2 above shall be paid no later than July 12, 2021, by certified check delivered to the Receiver.
