1. The Thirteenth Fee Application is APPROVED.
2. The fees and expenses incurred by the Receiver and his professionals, as set forth in the Thirteenth Fee Application, are reasonable and necessary, and may be paid as an expense of administering the receivership estate.
3. The Receiver is authorized to pay the Receiver, Klein & Associates, PLLC, Parr Brown Gee & Loveless, P.C., Manning Curtis Bradshaw & Bednar, PLLC, and Lone Peak Valuation Group \$152,619.89 in fees for services rendered for the benefit of the Receivership Estate from October 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, and \$3,110.31 as reimbursement of expenses paid on behalf of the Receivership Estate.
