**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S
MOTION TO ASSIGN CERTAIN
JUDGMENTS TO PLAINTIFF,

Before the Court is *Receiver's Motion to Assign Certain Judgments to Plaintiff, United States* (the "Motion") filed by R. Wayne Klein, the Court-Appointed Receiver (the "Receiver") in the above-captioned case, seeking approval to assign seven judgments entered by this Court to Plaintiff, United States.

In the Motion, the Receiver asserts that assigning these judgments to the United States will be more effective and efficient than if the judgments were collected by the Receiver, assigned to outside collection agencies, or sold to third parties.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED;
2. The Receiver is authorized to assign to the United States the judgments entered in the following cases:
