The Receiver is authorized to pay the Receiver, Klein & Associates, PLLC, Parr Brown Gee & Loveless, P.C., Manning Curtis Bradshaw & Bednar, PLLC, and Lone Peak Valuation Group \$86,521.50 in fees for services rendered for the benefit of the Receivership Estate from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022, and \$1,833.84 as reimbursement of expenses paid on behalf of the Receivership Estate.
