APPROVAL TO CONSUMMATE
SETTLEMENT WITH NELSON,
SNUFFER, DAHLE & POULSEN**

R. Wayne Klein, the Court-Appointed Receiver (the "Receiver") in the above-captioned case, filed the Twenty-Second Motion for Approval to Consummate Settlement: Nelson, Snuffer, Dahle & Poulsen (the "Motion").¹ In the Motion, the Receiver seeks the approval of a settlement agreement ("Settlement Agreement") with Nelson, Snuffer, Dahle & Poulsen, the defendant in *Klein v. Nelson, Snuffer, Dahle & Poulsen*, 2:19-cv-00851, an ancillary action pending in this court. The settlement agreement will bring \$925,000.00 in cash into the Receivership Estate.

The Motion contains important details on the settlement and the reasons the Receiver recommends settlement of this litigation.

The government has informed the Receiver that it consents to the relief requested.

Based on the Motion, and for good cause appearing,


