IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

In addition to other filing requirements, Defendant R. Gregory Shepard must complete a summary of his financial circumstances, including a complete statement of income, expenses, assets, and liabilities. Shepard must file this summary under seal and deliver a copy to the Receiver by *May 15*, 2019.

Thereafter, the Receiver must confer with Shepard regarding Shepard's financial circumstances and evaluate the adequacy of the living expenses allowance Shepard receives.

Shepard's current living allowance was set by national standards without consideration of his specific circumstances, including available income, necessary expenses, assets, and liabilities.

The Receiver is further directed to file a recommendation for any changes to Shepard's living expenses allowance by *May 24, 2019*.
