**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S
MOTION FOR FEES AND COSTS
AGAINST PACIFIC STOCK
TRANSFER COMPANY**

The court-appointed receiver, R. Wayne Klein, (“Receiver”) filed a motion (“Motion”) requesting an award of attorneys’ fees, nontaxable expenses, and receiver fees in the total amount of \$6,160.40 against Pacific Stock Transfer Company (“PSTC”).¹ Although PSTC was properly served with the Motion,² it has not filed a response to the Motion, and the deadline to do so has now expired.³ Therefore, based on the Motion and evidence presented, and for good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:


1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. In accordance with the Order re: Civil Contempt of Pacific Stock Transfer Co.,³

PSTC shall pay the Receiver’s reasonable fees and costs in the total amount of \$6,160.40 to the Receiver in full by no later than August 1, 2019.
