In accordance with the Civil Contempt Order re: R. Gregory Shepard, Neldon Johnson, Glenda Johnson, LaGrand Johnson, and Randale Johnson (“Contempt Order”),¹ Plaintiff United States of America filed a motion (the “Motion”)² seeking an award of attorneys’ fees and costs in the total amount of \$25,146.85. No response to the Motion has been filed, and the time to file a response has now expired. Therefore, for the reasons stated in the Contempt Order and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. In accordance with the Contempt Order, R. Gregory Shepard, Neldon Johnson, Glenda Johnson, LaGrand Johnson, and Randale Johnson are jointly and severally liable to the

United States for the total amount of \$25,146.85, which must be paid in funds separate from property belonging to the Receiver or the receivership estate.

3. By no later than August 15, 2019, R. Gregory Shepard, Neldon Johnson, Glenda Johnson, LaGrand Johnson, and Randale Johnson shall cause a certified check to be delivered to counsel for the United States made out to "U.S. Department of Justice" for the total amount stated in Paragraph 2 of this Order.
