R. Wayne Klein, the Court-Appointed Receiver (the "Receiver"), in the above-captioned case, filed the Receiver's Fourth Motion for Approval to Consummate Settlements (the "Motion").<sup>1</sup> In the Motion, the Receiver seeks the approval of twelve (12) settlement agreements and releases ("Settlement Agreements") that will bring \$213,160.68 into the Receivership Estate. 
